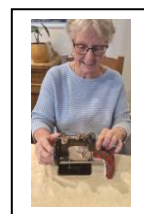

Rolleston residents donated 145 boxes in 1.5 hours.

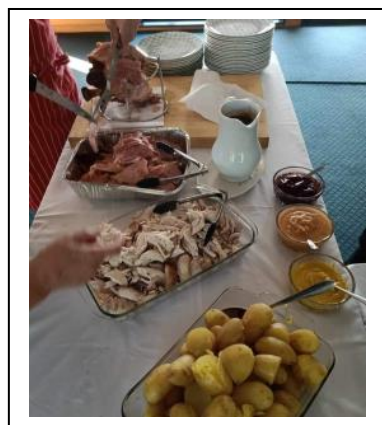
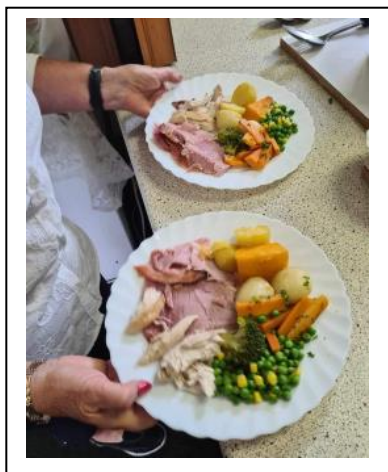
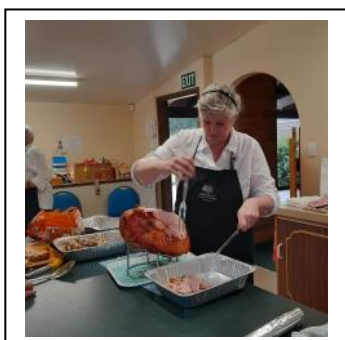
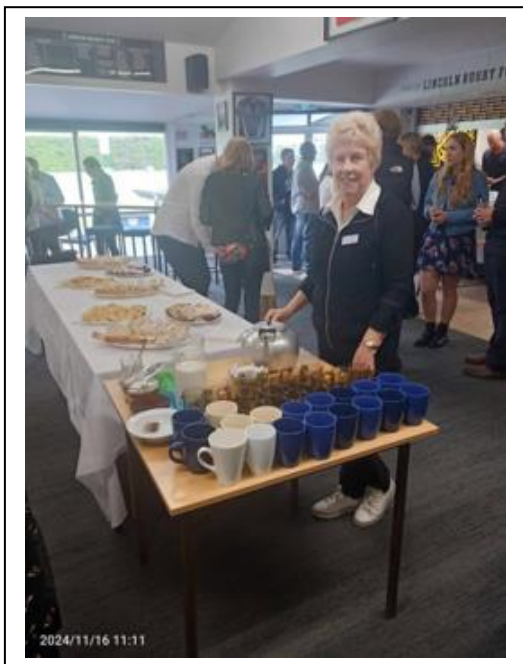


All gratefully received by the three Foodbanks within the Selwyn area.
