their feet with the aid of a Hart Walker and actually do that.

This device has enabled many to join in activities with family and
their peers as well as helping the development of lungs, internal
organs and muscles, with added stimulus for mental activity.

At the recent Multi District Convention in New Plymouth we were fortunate to have a local girl whom Lions assisted come to visit us, and her parents Fraser and Pip gave us an insight into her story and how CMF has helped to enrich Olivia's life and aided them as a family to enjoy many of the aspects of life we take for granted.

Using both a Hart Walker and a special tricycle, two of the several means that CMF can help.



International Dues Increase

Our Club Treasurers will have all seen the latest message on the statements in the Portal:


'The approved dues adjustment will be effective July 1, 2025. Dues for the 2025-26 term will increase to US\$50 per year. The updated dues billing table can be found on the association's website. Paper statements will no longer be mailed after July 15, 2025.'

The fee increase was voted in at an International Convention a few years ago.

The international dues have been slowly increasing over the past few years (USD\$2 per year).

This year clubs were charged US\$24 in both July and January, so US\$48 for the year.

In July this year it will increase to US\$25 per six monthly invoices (so US\$50 per annum).
