Born in Tuscumbia, Alabama, USA, in 1880, Helen Keller developed a fever at 18 months of age that left hillind and deaf

With the help of an exceptional teacher, Amer Mansfield Sullivan of the Persins School for the Blind, Helen Kallel learned sign lenguage and braille. A few years later, the learned to pages. As an adult he became a triese advocate for people with disabilities. And in 1925, she attended the Lions Clubs International Convention and

he Lions accepted her challenge and our work ever since has included <mark>sight programs</mark> almed at preventab lindness.
